ACCO SAFETY DEPARTMENT RENTAL AGREEMENT

Thank you for using our videos in your safety programs, please note that these videos are for all the counties to use and learn from. Therefore your help, in the return of these videos, in the allotted time period, is critical to the process.

Also note that these videos cost all of us money, therefore we are all interested in protecting our investments. So be aware that if you lose or destroy this/these tape(s), you may be subject to the cost of the tape at the discretion of the ACCO board.

Policy:

1. Tapes can be checked-out up to 3 at a time
2. Tapes must be returned no later than 1 month from date of check-out
 - a. An exception of 1 additional month will apply to those who call in advance or come by and re-check out the video(s), unless the video(s) have been reserved by another party.
 - b. A third additional month will be granted upon special request, but not to exceed a total of 3 months, and will also be subject to reservations made prior to your request by other parties.
3. No tape transfers are allowed from county to county.
4. Tapes will only be checked-out to you by ACCO employees.
5. Counties will not be subject to the cost of the tape if:
 - a. It is stolen
 - b. The VCR ate the tape(Note if your VCR has a history of eating tapes then you may be subject to the cost of the tape)

* We know that accidents can and will happen so liability for the cost of the tapes will be further determined by the ACCO board.
