### Damon Lane, Chief Meteorologist KOCO News 5

Damon Lane is Chief Meteorologist for KOCO 5 First Alert Weather.

Lane is the only Chief Meteorologist in Oklahoma City who holds a degree in Atmospheric Sciences/Meteorology. He is also the only Chief Meteorologist in Oklahoma City to hold the CBM seal of approval from The American Meteorological Society, the highest level certification from the nation's top association for broadcast meteorologists. Lane and the KOCO 5 First Alert Weather team are independently certified as delivering the most accurate forecast in Oklahoma City by WeatheRate, an independent scientific organization that measures accuracy in weather forecasts across the country.

Lane was born and raised in Northern Virginia and was drawn to science and weather from a young age. Lane earned two bachelor degrees in college. After graduating in less than four years in Communications/Mass Media from Old Dominion University, Lane earned his Bachelor of Science in Atmospheric Sciences/ Meteorology from The University of North Carolina, Asheville.

While he takes his weather science seriously, during his free time Lane is just as serious about having fun out in the elements. An avid outdoorsman, he loves to hike in summer and snow ski in winter. He shares his love of the outdoors and traveling with his wife Melissa. Being new parents hasn't slowed them down and they love to share their travel adventures with their daughter.

When he's not exploring the outdoors with his family, he enjoys firing up the barbeque at home and is convinced that he makes the world's best "jalapeno poppers."

### ABOUT THE SPEAKERS

#### Representative Jon Echols

In 2012, Jon Echols was elected to represent House District 90 in the Oklahoma House of Representatives.

Jon Echols graduated from the University of Oklahoma with a Political Science degree. He then went on to Oklahoma City University School of Law, where he received numerous academic awards and graduated first in his class.

Jon Echols, his wife Kristen, and their three children attend Capitol Hill Baptist Church.

Echols has championed numerous conservative causes during his 11 years in the House. He currently serves as House Majority Floor Leader and is the longest-serving Majority Floor Leader in state history.

### Oklahoma State Auditor Cindy Byrd

Cindy Byrd, CPA, is Oklahoma's 13th State Auditor & Inspector, the first woman elected to this statewide-elected office, and she is the only candidate to top the 800,000-vote milestone in an election for state office in Oklahoma History.

Byrd served as Deputy State Auditor & Inspector for Local Government Services from January 2013 before assuming her new role on January 14, 2019. She previously served as Director of the County Audit Division.

Byrd earned a Bachelor of Science in Accounting degree from East Central University in Ada. She is a Certified Public Accountant with over 20 years of governmental auditing experience.

Cindy is a solutions-oriented auditor who has designed and implemented effective plans that have eliminated backlogs of audits and uncovered waste of public funds at all levels of government. Her public service includes planning and conducting county audits, district attorney audits, emergency medical services district audits, and investigative audits.

Byrd is currently at the forefront of the State Auditor & Inspector's role to safeguard public assets and to improve the efficient delivery of government services.

Cindy and her husband Steve live in Coalgate located in Coal County, Oklahoma.

### Tim Gatz, Executive Director of ODOT

Tim Gatz was appointed Executive Director of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation by Gov. Kevin Stitt in 2019 and reappointed in 2024.

Prior to that designation, Gatz also served as Secretary of Transportation and the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority. He has dedicated more than three decades to transportation.

Gatz earned a bachelor's degree in landscape architecture from Oklahoma State University in 1989 and is a registered professional landscape architect. He has received several honors including the Oklahoma Good Roads & Transportation Association's Bill Skeith Stewardship Award, the Governor's Public Service Award and the Federal Highway Administration's Partners In Quality Award. He is a member of the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials, the International Bridge, Tunnel and Turnpike Association and the American Society of Landscape Architects.

Gatz and his wife, Sandy, live in El Reno and have two sons.




