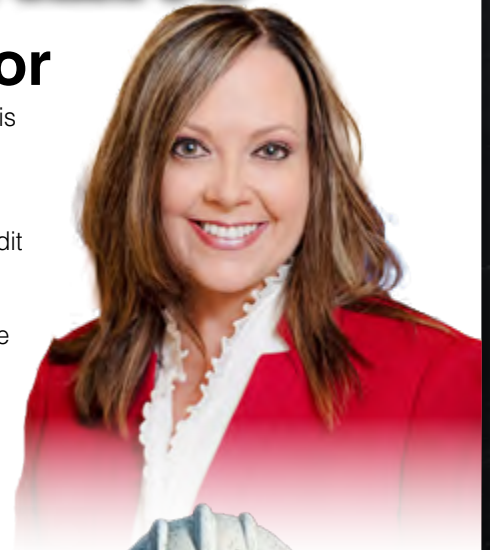
Cindy Byrd, Oklahoma State Auditor

Cindy Byrd is Oklahoma's 13th State Auditor & Inspector and the first woman elected to this statewide-elected office.

Byrd served as Deputy State Auditor & Inspector for Local Government Services before assuming this role in January of 2019. She previously served as Director of the County Audit Division.

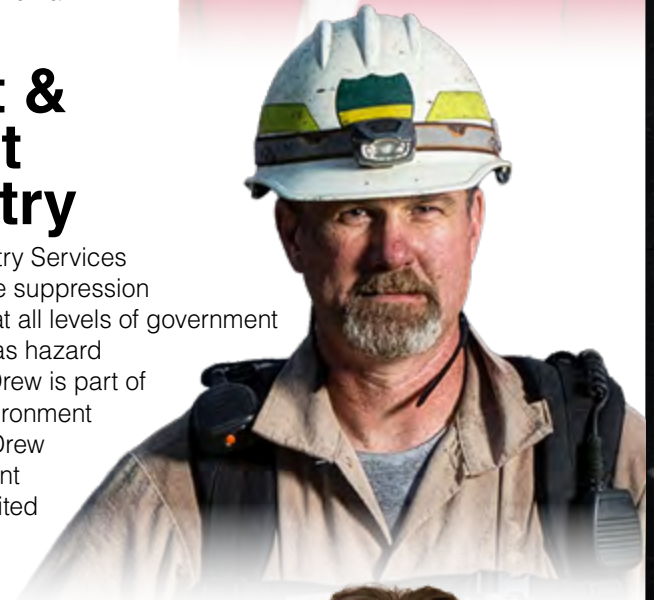
Byrd earned a Bachelor of Science in Accounting degree from East Central University. She is a Certified Public Accountant with over 20 years of governmental auditing experience. Her public service includes planning and conducting county audits, district attorney audits, emergency medical services district audits, and investigative audits.

Cindy and her husband Steve live in Coalgate located in Coal County, Oklahoma.



Drew Daily, Fire Management & Field Operations, Department of Agriculture, Food, & Forestry

Drew Daily serves as Deputy Fire Management Chief with Oklahoma Forestry Services (Operations & Preparedness). Within this role, he is responsible for both fire suppression operations and prescribed fire management. Working alongside partners at all levels of government is a critical function of his work for wildfire readiness and response as well as hazard mitigation including both prescribed fire and mechanical fuel treatments. Drew is part of the Southern Great Plains Wildfire Outbreak Group, Southern Area Fire Environment Group and National Wildfire Coordinating Group committee. Additionally, Drew serves as Operations Section Chief on the Northern Rockies Team 1 Incident Management Team responding to complex wildfire incidents across the United States.



Tim Gatz, Oklahoma Secretary of Transportation

Tim Gatz was appointed Executive Director of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation by Gov. Kevin Stitt in 2019 and reappointed in 2024.

Prior to that designation, Gatz also served as Secretary of Transportation and the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority. He has dedicated more than three decades to transportation.

Gatz earned a bachelor's degree in landscape architecture from Oklahoma State University in 1989 and is a registered professional landscape architect. He has received several honors including the Oklahoma Good Roads & Transportation Association's Bill Skeith Stewardship Award, the Governor's Public Service Award and the Federal Highway Administration's Partners In Quality Award. He is a member of the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials, the International Bridge, Tunnel and Turnpike Association and the American Society of Landscape Architects.

Gatz and his wife, Sandy live in El Reno and have two sons.

Charles McCall is a fifth-generation Oklahoman, lifelong conservative, and dedicated public servant who has always believed in faith, family, and freedom. Born and raised in Atoka, Charles learned early on what it means to work hard, serve your community, and live by your values. Chip and his wife, Brittney, have been married for 20 years and are raising their three children in Oklahoma. A third-generation Oklahoman and the son of former Governor Frank Keating and First lady Cathy Keating, Chip is proud of his family's legacy of service — and he is ready to continue that tradition by fighting for a safer, stronger, and more prosperous Oklahoma.

GENTNER DRUMMOND, OKLAHOMA ATTORNEY GENERAL

Gentner Drummond has spent his life fighting for freedom, upholding justice, and defending the values that make Oklahoma great. As a decorated fighter pilot and tough-on-crime Attorney General, he has proven that he will stand strong for our families and our future.

When his nation called, Captain Gentner Drummond answered with courage. Leading the first U.S. combat mission of the Gulf War, he was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross for “extraordinary achievement.” By the end of Operation Desert Storm, Capt. CYNDI MUNSON, OKLAHOMA STATE REPRESENTATIVE

Cyndi Munson is one of us. She has overcome life’s challenges to be where she is today, working to help others.

The daughter of a Vietnam War Veteran and a South Korean immigrant, Cyndi grew up in Lawton. Cyndi and her younger sister were raised by their single father, who worked multiple jobs while serving in the U.S. Army. To make ends meet, her family had to move every year chasing cheaper rent. Cyndi would move 10 times before graduating high school, all in the same town.

After graduating from Lawton Eisenhower High School, Cyndi attended the University of Central Oklahoma and became the first person in her family to graduate from college, only because of the Oklahoma’s Promise scholarship program, which provides free in-state college tuition to low-income families.

Cyndi spent over a decade working in the non-profit community. At the Girl Scouts of Western Oklahoma she provided leadership programs for thousands of girls in low-income schools, juvenile detention centers, and public housing. Cyndi also spent time at a

Cyndi lives in Oklahoma City and enjoys running, reading, rowing, hiking, painting, puzzles, and mentoring young women across the state. Most of all, she loves spending time with her nephew, Jude.

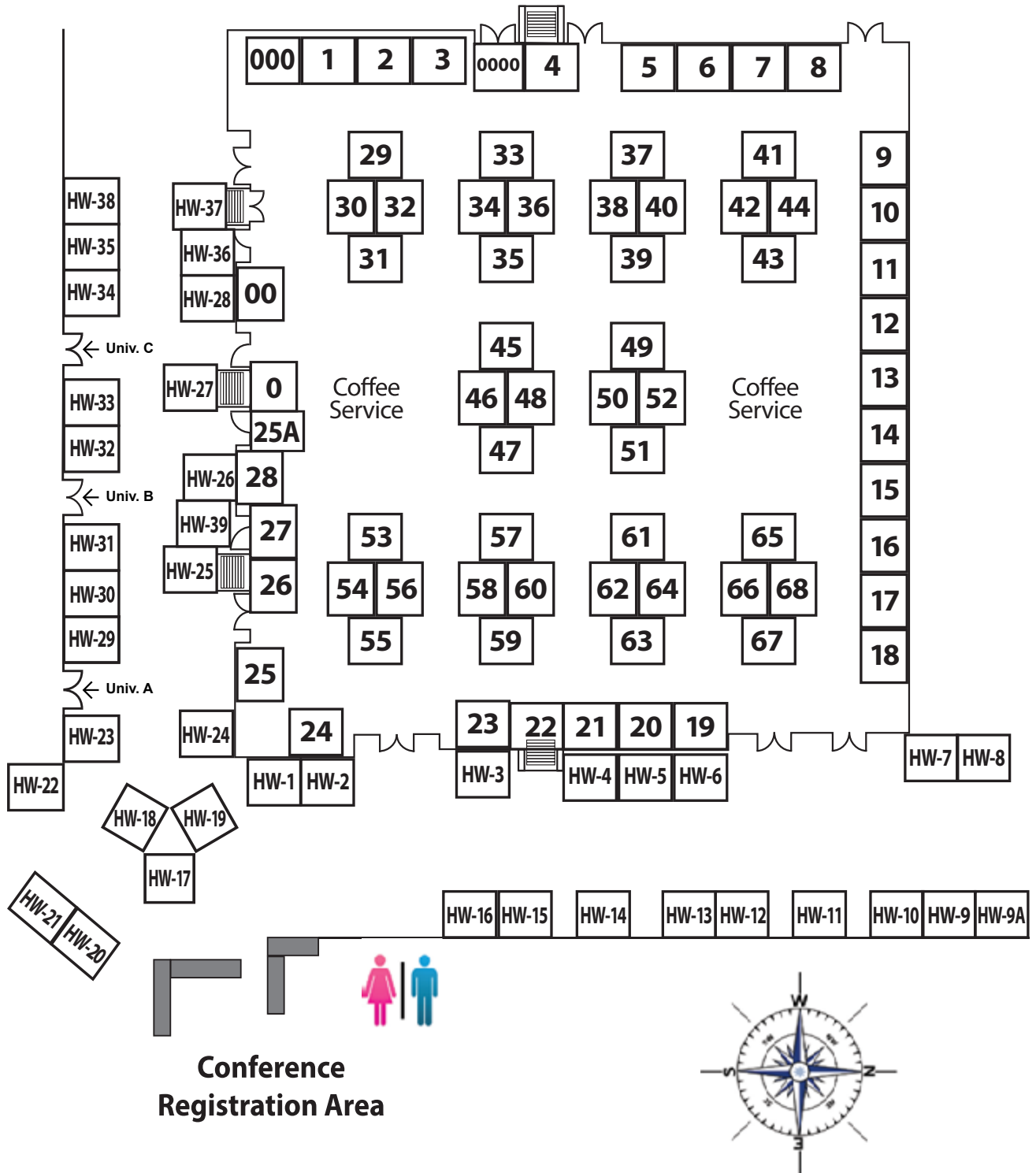

We are excited to share that the Embassy Suites will be renovating the hotel rooms, completing several floors at one time.

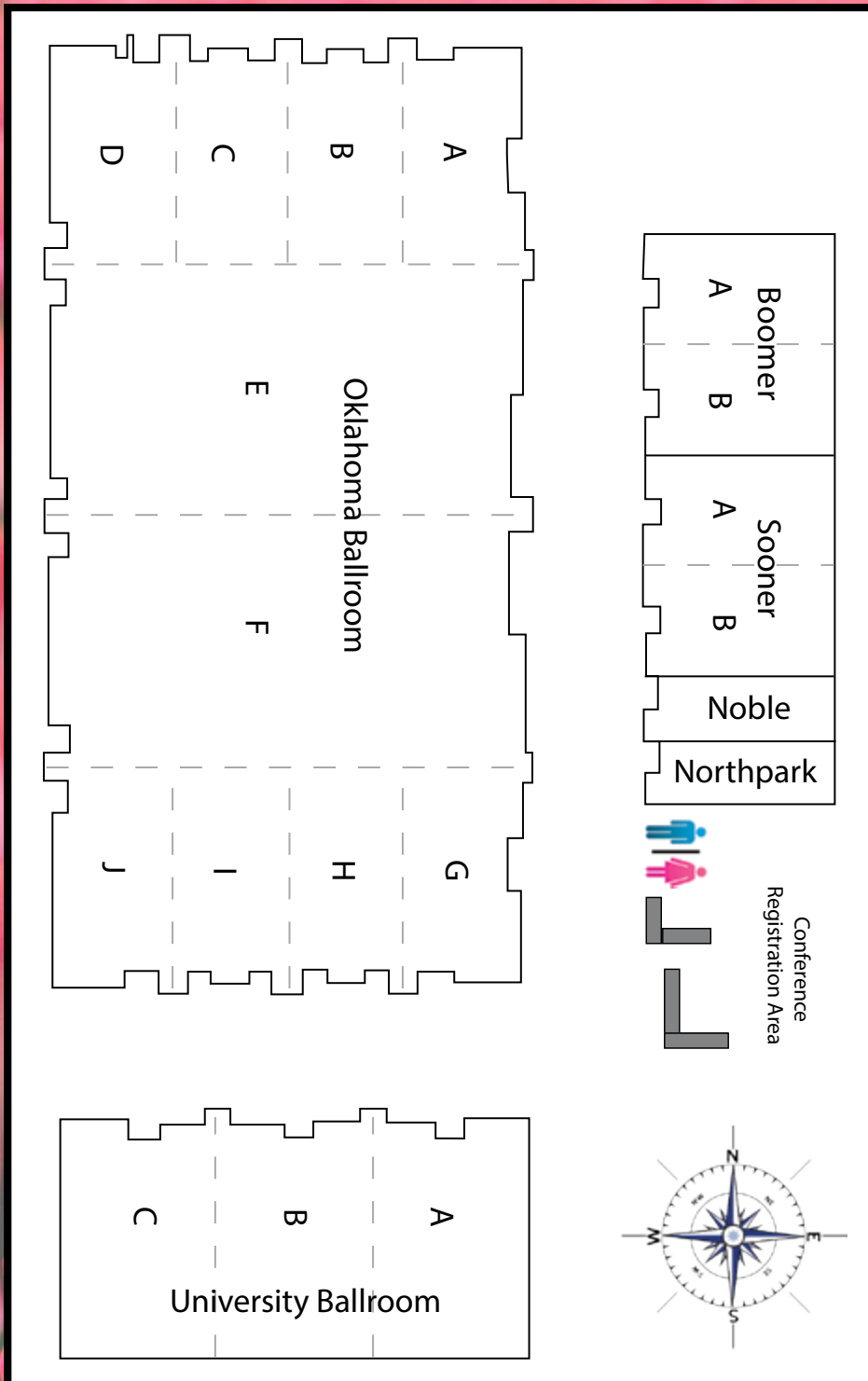
This will affect one of our conferences, which is ACCO Spring Conference 2027.
